Sub : C&DSE – Accounts – Educational Concession to the children of Non-Gazetted Officers – Clarification on Scale of pay - Reg.

I wish to inform that the General Secretary, 'The State Teachers' Union of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in his represented 2<sup>nd</sup> cited has represented that certain Treasury Officers in districts are rejecting the claims of Educational Concession to the children of Secondary Grade Teachers (NGOs) who have completed 12 years service and appointed to SAPP-I A scale of Rs.14860-39540 and also Schools Assistants in the regular scale of Rs.14860-39540.

In this connection, Government clarified through their Memo 1<sup>st</sup> cited to you that the scheme of reimbursement of tuition fee shall be allowed to all the Class-IV employees and Non-Gazetted Officers.

The Secondary Grade Teachers are also belonging to category of Non-Gazetted Officers and they are also eligible for the said scheme as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.2, Education (Ser.IV) Department, dated 05.01.2011. The award of SPP-I A&B scales may not change their NGO status. Similarly the School Assistant category also belong to NGOs though they are given the scale of Gazetted Officers i.e. Rs.14860-39540. In the Govt. Memo 1<sup>st</sup> cited, it is clarified that NGOs are eligible for the scheme without linking it to the scales of pay.

In view of above, necessary instructions may be issued to all the Treasury Officers in this regard at the earliest for admission of claims of SGTs / SAs under the scheme.
