

(b) The day on which a Government servant retires or is retired or is discharged or is allowed to resign or voluntarily retire from service, as the case may be, shall be treated as a non-working day but the date of death shall be treated as a working day.

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[(c) Any type of Pension sanctioned under these rules except family pension, shall be subject to Rule 45.]

A.P.FINANCIAL CODE

Furnishing of C.T.Cs on transfer of Gazetted Officer - Signing of C.T.Cs by Gazetted Officers has been dispensed with except in the case of Heads of Depts. (Govt. Memo.No. 2206/G.A.D. General/81-1 dt. 17-3-1982).

**Payment Due to Deceased Employees : (Art 80)** ✓

Pay leave salary and other emoluments of a Govt employee died can be drawn for the day of death irrespective of the hour at which the death has taken place. ✓

The payment can be made without production of legal heir certificate unless there is doubt. In respect of Non-gazetted Officers, the pay and allowances of all kinds including T.A. (T.A. inserted in G.O.Ms.No. 120 F & P dt. 6-5-88) relating to deceased employees can be drawn and paid by the Head of Office in which the Govt servant was last employed, if the gross amount of the claim does not exceed Rs. 5,000/-. If the Head of the Office is an N.G.O. the claim should be sanctioned by the immediate Gazetted Officer. If the amount exceeds Rs. 5,000/- it should be drawn and paid with the sanction of the Head of the Dept after obtaining an indemnity Board in Form VI. One surety can be accepted upto Rs. 7,500/- if the surety is financially sound and two sureties are required beyond Rs. 7,500/- (G.O.Ms.No. 301 Fin. dt. 24-8-87)
