2. The Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad has also reported that it is difficult to depute the inspection team from Andhra Pradesh to Telangana to conduct inspection in existing Private Hospitals in the residuary Telangana State, for the purpose of Medical Reimbursement.
3. In the circumstance, the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad has requested the Government to kindly issue necessary orders to recognize the existing already recognized Private Referral Hospital in Telangana State, to all employees/pensioners of Government of Andhra Pradesh for taking treatment in those Hospitals locatd in Telangana State, since 2-6-2014 and also requested to instruct the authorities Pay & Accounts Department to accept the proceedings in this regard.
4. After careful examination of the matter, Government hereby accord permission to the Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad to recognize the existing already recognized Private Referral Hospital in Telangana State, to all employees/pensioners of Government of Andhra Pradesh for taking treatment in those Hospitals located in Telangana State, since 2-6-2014.
5. The Director of Medical Education, AP, Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly in the matter.

advance to establish EHS. Revolving Fund to be operated exclusively for the purpose of EHS. This amount shall be a permanent advance to the NTR Vaidya Seva for the purpose of EHS and shall be replenished every month or earlier based on the submission of certified statement of expenditure (SOE) by the Chief Executive Officer of NTR Vaidya Seva Trust. At any given time, the Trust would have funds adequate to finance two months of EHS payments in its PD account.

The Chief Executive Officer of Dr. NTR Vaidya Seva Trust shall settle the claims of the Hospitals relating to EHS within fifteen days of the claim being preferred by the hospital and there shall be no lapse in this regard. Further, the Vaidya Seva Trust shall not mix EHS implementation with other programmes being implemented by the agency.

The Director of Treasuries and Accounts and the CEO of Dr. NTR Vaidya Seva Trust shall reconcile accounts relating to EHS every month before the fifteenth day of the following month and furnish reports to the government.

The Principal Secretary of Medical and Health Department and the Finance Secretary (Expenditure) will jointly review the implementation of EHS every quarter and take immediate remedial action as required to ensure smooth and streamlined implementation of the EHS.

2. The Steering Committee of the EHS that includes all stakeholders will review the implementation of the scheme periodically and make necessary recommendations for effective implementation of the scheme. This procedure for operation of EHS guidelines shall become operational with immediate effect.

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

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

3. The Hospital should provide better medical and health services including free diagnostic services, conducting health camps, once in a month in two villages which are mentioned in the M.O.U.
4. The Hospital should submit monthly return in the prescribed format.
5. The Hospital concerned should charge for all medical / surgical / diagnostic services given by them under this scheme, as per the package rates prescribed by Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for C.G.H.S., Hyderabad and as adopted by the State Government in G.O. Ms. No. 74, HM&FW (K.1) Department, Dated. 15-03-2005 or as may be prescribed by the State Government or the Director of Medical Education from time to time. The Director of Medical Education / Scrutinizing authority shall verify and ensure that the charges levied by the Private Hospitals are as per the above rates, before certifying the net admissible amount.
