#### ORDER:

In the G.O.1<sup>st</sup> read above, Government have provided certain exemptions and concessions to the children with Special Needs (CwSN) in SSC examinations and other examinations of classes VI to X to retain them in schools and to encourage them to complete their secondary education successfully.

- 2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Secretary, DSE&L, GoI has informed that National Education Policy, 2020 reaffirms the provisions contained in the Rights of Person with Disability Act 2016 in regard to students with disability. Section 17 of this Act mandates that the appropriate Government and local authorities must "make suitable modifications in the curriculum and examination system to meet the needs of students with disabilities such as extra time for completion of examination paper, facility of scribe or amanuensis, exemption from second and third language course." Therefore, the Secretary, has requested to review the existing provisions for CwSN in A.P. State Boards, revise them, accordingly notify in Government rules and facilitate for implementation of these provisions for CwSN as per Section 17 of the RPwD Act and NEP 2020, so that there are uniform provisions across all Boards with clear eligibility criteria.
- 3. In the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, the Commissioner of School Education, A.P., has stated that, to facilitate every student in the State to complete his/her secondary education with ease, reduce the drop-out rates, provide equal opportunities and level-playing field to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN), certain provisions & concessions are to be provided to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) in SSC Public Examinations (Class-X) and other examinations from Class-VI to Class-X in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The Constitution of India ensures equality, freedom, justice and dignity of all individuals including Persons with disabilities and mandates an inclusive society for all. Article 41 of the Constitution of India declares that the State shall, within the limits of its economic capacity and development, make effective provisions for securing the right to work, to education and to public assistance in cases of unemployment, old age, sickness and disablement and in other cases of undeserved want.

Further, National Education Policy 2020 recognizes the importance of creating enabling mechanisms for providing CwSN the ame opportunities for obtaining quality education as any other child and reaffirms the provisions contained in the Rights of Persons with Disability Act 2016. The Director of Government Examinations, AP has undertaken the task of revising the present exemption & concessions which are being provided for the CwSN in the SSC Public Examinations to implement the objectives of NEP 2020 in the right spirit. After a detailed study of the provisions provided by CBSE as well as the RPwD Act, 2016 and other orders of the Social Justice and Empowerment Department in this regard. Accordingly, the Commissioner of School Education, AP has submitted necessary proposal for exemptions and concessions to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) in the SSC Public Examinations and other examinations of Classes VI to X.

- 4. Government, after careful examination of the matter, hereby order to provide exemptions and concessions indicated at Annexure-I and II, appended to the G.O., to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) in the State of Andhra Pradesh from the SSC Public Examinations, March-2022 and other examinations of Classes VI to X from the Academic Year 2021-22, duly superseding the earlier orders issued in the G.O. 1<sup>st</sup> read above.
- The Commissioner of School Education, A.P., and the Director of Government Examinations, A.P., shall take further action accordingly, in the matter.

- 4. The Chief Superintendent of the Examination Centre shall form a panel of eligible scribes/readers/prompters (as per the eligibility criteria) to be provided to the CwSN candidates in the examination centres under their control and submit the list to the concerned District Educational Officer for approval. The District Educational Officer shall communicate the approved list to the Commissioner of School Education, A.P., and Director of Government Examinations, A.P.
- 5.The 'Standard Operating Procedure' (SOP) for availing the exemptions, the proforma for the 'letter of undertaking' for using own scribe shall be framed and communicated to all the stakeholders by the DGE, A.P., with the prior approval of the Commissioner of School Education, A.P.
- 6. A dedicated Grievance Redressal Helpline to support the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) and other stakeholders before/during/after the examinations shall be constituted by the DGE, A.P. and the information shall be made available in the public domain and shall be widely circulated to all the stakeholders.

The Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O. Ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, has ordered to provide exemptions and concessions to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) in the state of Andhra Pradesh from the SSC Public Examinations, 2022 onwards duly superseding the earlier orders issued in the G.O. Ref. 1<sup>st</sup> cited.

2. In pursuance of the Orders issued in the G.O. Ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited and the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and the Notification of the Government of India vide Ref. 4<sup>th</sup> cited and after due consideration of the representation and the circumstances reported in the representation Ref. 7<sup>th</sup> cited, in partial modification of the instructions issued in the Lr. Ref. 6<sup>th</sup> cited, all the HMs/ Principals/ Correspondents of all the High Schools in the state of Andhra Pradesh presenting CwSN candidates for the SSC Public Examinations, April/May-2022 are hereby informed that the exemptions and concessions stated below shall be extended to the following categories of CwSN who are appearing for the SSC Public Examinations, April/May-2022 in addition to the various categories of CwSN mentioned in the para 1(a) of Annexure-I and Annexure-II of the G.O. Ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited:

All other disability codes and disability-specific exemptions remain unchanged.
- b. The Definition of Disabilities are as defined in the Schedule of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 read with the Notification of the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi, published in the Gazette of India (Extraordinary), Part-II, Section 3(ii), No. 61, Dated: 05-01-2018.
- 5. All the details regarding the Issuing Authority Medical Certificate are listed in Para (2) of Annexure-1 of the G.O. Ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited. Only the Disability Certificate issued by the listed competent authorities (Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent etc.) are accepted. The Medical certificates issued by the "Assistant Civil Surgeon" shall not be accepted by the HMs to avail the exemptions and concessions. Further, the Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority at any place i.e., at any district/state within the jurisdiction of the Republic of India shall be accepted.
- 6. The candidates suffering from Multiple Disabilities (Disability Code: SD) can avail of the exemptions and concessions provided in the G.O.Ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited based on the nature of Disabilities listed. The concerned HM of the school is advised to forward the Medical Certificates of such candidates to the O/o DGE, A.P. for further course of action, and the exemptions and concessions shall be provided on a case by case basis considering the nature of disabilities.
- 7. All the HMs/ Principals/ Correspondents of all the High Schools in the state of Andhra Pradesh presenting CwSN candidates for the SSC Public Examinations, April/May-2022 are hereby instructed to scrupulously follow the orders of the Government in the G.O. Ref. 2nd cited, the HM Instructions and the orders in these proceedings while submitting the applications of the candidates.
- 8. All the District Educational Officers are also requested to consider this as a priority and issue Press notes in district editions of all the widely circulated newspapers and also utilize the social media applications such as Whatsapp

etc. to communicate the new provisions to the HMs and students. It is requested to utilize the services of the IE Coordinators in the state for faster dissemination of information and also utilize the already communicated District Wise CwSN data to the fullest extent to reach out to all the stakeholders to create awareness among them about the new provisions and to persuade them to make use of these accommodations to achieve the ultimate objective of increasing the turnout of CwSN in the SSC Public Examinations, April/May-2022 as well as to reduce the dropout rates among the Children with Special Needs in the state.

#### **CIRCULAR**

<u>Sub:</u>Exemptions/ Concessions extended to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) in the SSC Public Examinations (Class-X) – Provisions regarding availing the Services of Scribe/ Reader – Scribe Rules – Certain guidelines – Reg.

- Ref: 1. G.O.Ms.No. 86, SE (Prog.II) Dept, Dated: 29-12-2021.

  - 3. CBSE Circular vide No. CBSE/COORD/112233/2019, Dated: 12-04-2019. & Notice Dated: 27-11-2021.

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All the District Educational Officers and all the HMs/ Heads of High Schools of all the managements in the State are hereby informed that, the Government of Andhra Pradesh had provided certain exemptions & concessions to the Children with Special Needs (CwSN) in the SSC Public Examinations vide Ref. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> cited as per the provisions of the RPwD Act, 2016, NEP 2020 and the provisions extended by the CBSE to ensure uniformity in the CwSN provisions in all the High Schools of the State.

- 2. Further, several representations have been received regarding clarifications on the 'Provisions to avail the services of Scribe' in the SSC Public Examinations. It was brought to the notice of the undersigned that certain categories of CwSN could not avail the services of the scribe.
- 3. In this regard, it is hereby informed that, the CwSN who could not write the examinations by themselves have a right to avail of the Services of the Scribe. The Scribe plays an important role in the examination of CwSN by writing the dictated answers of the CwSN. However, the primary principle that "The Use of Scribe should neither advantage nor disadvantage the student" has to be upheld. The provision to avail Scribe by CwSN is to provide a level playing field and ensure equity by assisting the student to overcome their natural disadvantages. This implicitly needs clear guidelines to eliminate the misuse and to ensure justice for the needy.
- 4. Further, the exemptions and concessions provided in the SSC Public Examinations are broadly based on the CBSE's provisions mentioned in the Circular Ref. 3<sup>rd</sup> cited. This is to ensure uniformity in CwSN provisions

across all the High Schools of the state irrespective of their affiliation.

5. In this regard, in accordance with the earlier orders of the Government cited above, the following clarification & guidelines are hereby issued regarding the provisions on the Scribe for the CwSN in the SSC Public Examinations:

- 6. The Educational Qualification of the Scribe/ Reader shall be one grade lower than the minimum stipulated eligibility criteria for the candidate i.e., for the Class-X SSC Public Examinations, the Scribe should possess an educational qualification of Class-IX or less.
- 7. The Chief Superintendent of the Examination Centre concerned shall forward to the Concerned Assistant Commissioner for Government Examinations (ACGE) in the O/o DEO of the District, a report providing full particulars of the candidate and that of the Scribe atleast 2 days before the commencement of examinations.
- 8. In case of any doubt regarding the eligibility of the candidate to avail of the services of the Scribe, the Concerned Assistant Commissioner for Government Examinations (ACGE) in the O/o DEO shall verify the Original Disability Certificate of the Candidate & the candidate in person, if required, and shall decide on the eligibility according to the Government Orders and this circular, and the decision of the ACGE, O/o DEO, in this regard, shall be final.
- 9. Therefore, the Director of Government Examinations, A.P. and all the District Educational Officers shall take necessary action to disseminate the instructions to all the stakeholders in this regard, for strict compliance.
