Sub:- Establishment, - Z.P. - District Selection committee, 1989 - Recruitment of 912 Spl. teachers in the post allotted in G.O.Ms.No.670, Edn., dt.6-5-1995 and G.O.No.156, Edn., (Ser.III) Department, dt.8-7-1996, in each District, as per the Hon'ble High Court Judgement dated 28-8-2000 in W.P.Nos.10586, 10683, 10684, 10685, 10686, 10687, of 1999 and High Court Judgements in Similar Writ Petitions - Instruction for absorption - Issued.

The attention of the under mentioned District Educational Officers in the State is invited to the references 1st to 5th read above, and they are informed that certain teachers were appointed as Special Teachers under Rs.398/- per month based on Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh Judgement dt.28-8-2000 in W.P.No.10586, 10683, 109684, 10685, 10686, 10687, of 1999.

The Special Teachers are constantly representing for their absorption. The Hon'ble High Court directed to appoint the Petitioners strictly in order of merit. According

the directions of Hon'ble High Court, the Government in their Memo.No.18788/Ser.VI/99, (Education Ser.VI Department) dated: 23-5-2001 had orderd for implementation of High Court orders dt.28-8-2000 in W.P.No.10586/99 and batch. According to the directions of the Hon'ble High Court the District Educational Officers in the State has completed the process of recruitment as per the schedule given by this office. These Special Teachers working on Rs.398/- consolidated pay have to be absorbed against regular vacancies, as and when the vacancies arise as per the original scheme, simultaneously winding up the posts of Special Teachers. According to the various Government Orders on the Special Teachers so appointed at Rs.398/- consolidated scheme as per the directions of Hon'ble High Court be absorbed, against the regular S.G.T. posts in the available vacancies in the district other than these notified during S.C.2001. The absorption should be made only in respect of these, who have been appointed strictly as per guidelines issued in reference 5th read above, and working as on the date of issue of these orders.

Since any new appointments to the post of S.G.T carries stipend during the first year, at the rate of Rs.1,200/ per month and Rs.1,500/- P.M. in second year, these Special teachers, on absorption, shall be paid the stipend, as applicable to the newly recruited S.G.T Teachers and they should be put on apprenticeship for two years.

The Seniority of the special Teachers now absorbed will be reckened from the date of their absorption into the regular vacancies of S.G.T.
