I invite kind attention to the references cited.

I am to state that the Deputy Director , District Treasury , East Godavari District requested this office that the claims which comes under Rule 6(g)(i) of G.O.Ms.NO.52 dt.25-2-2010 may be passed as the pay of the employees was fixed in the equal stage in Ordinary Grade and Special Grade under RPS 2010 as on 01-07-2008.

The Government have issued orders in the G.O. reference 1st cited, the Ruie 6(g)(i) is as follows 'Where the pay of a Government employee in a higher officiating or temporary post as fixed in the Revised Pay Scales 2010 is less than or equal to the pay

fixed in the lower post, his pay in the higher post shall be fixed at the stage next above his substantive pay in the lower post'.

I submit that the Government have issued orders in the reference 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} cited to allow 6(g)(i) under RPS 1993 when pay in the special grade is less or equal to the pay in the ordinary grade and pay in SPP-I Post is less or equal to the pay in the Special grade, the pay of the individual may be fixed at the stage next above the pay fixed in the higher post. But there are no specific instructions from the Government regarding admitting of the pay fixation claims under Rule 6(g)(i) under RPS 1999, RPS 2005 and RPS 2010 on the same anomaly.

On verification it is noticed that the Rule 6(g)(i) claims may also arise between the following stages in the basic pays in RPS 2005 if the claims allowed between Ordinary Grade and Special Grade and Special Grade and SPP- I scale.

In view of the above, I request the Government to kindly issue clarification whether the bills presented under Rule 6(g)(i) of G.O.Ms.No. 52 dt.25-2-2010 between the Ordinary Grade and Special Grade, Special Grade and SPP- I may be admitted into audit or between substantive pay and officiating pay only to be admitted.

The attention of the Director of Treasuries and Accounts is invited to the references cited wherein Associations / Unions representing Teachers have requested to extend the provision of Rule 6 (g) (i) of G.O.Ms.No.52, Finance (PC-I) Department, dated: 25.02.2010 to the pay fixations of teachers / employees holding the scales under Automatic Advancement Scheme, in Revised Scales, 2010.

- 2. After careful examination of the representations of the Teachers Unions, the Director of Treasuries and Accounts is hereby clarified that the Rule Rule 6 (g) (i) of G.O.Ms.No.52, Finance (PC-I) Department, dated: 25.02.2010 is applicable to the employees who are officiating in higher posts in the ordinary scale as on 01.07.2008, if the employees holding substantive post in the lower category carrying ordinary scale / Spl.Grade Scale prior to 01.07.2008 and subsequently appointed on promotion to higher officiating post shall be eligible for fixation of pay in the higher officiating post, on the basis of his higher pay in the substantive post. As no higher responsibilities are involved in respect of the post under Automatic Advancement Scheme as per the Government memo first cited, the above rule is not applicable to the pay fixations of the employees holding the scales under Automatic Advancement Scheme.
- 3. The Director of Treasuries and Accounts, A.P., Hyderabad is requested to reject such pay fixation bills presented under Rule 6 (g) (i) of G.O.Ms.No.52, Finance (PC-I) Department, dated: 25.02.2010 between Ordinary Grade and Special Grade, Special Grade and SPP-I/SAPP-I, and SPP-I/SAPP-I and SPP-II/SAPP-II.
